Re: Second Apportionment, Title II-Part A, Fiscal Year 2010-11

The purpose of this e-mail is to notify you that the California Department of Education (CDE) has sent an apportionment to the State Controller's Office for payment. This apportionment, in the amount of \$61,713,530, is made from federal funds provided to the state under Title II, Part A, of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended by the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, in support of grants awarded to eligible local educational agencies (LEAs) to achieve student academic achievement through strategies focused on recruiting, hiring, training, and retaining highly qualified teachers and principals.
