Dear County Superintendents of Schools:

2010-11 SECOND PRINCIPAL APPORTIONMENT

In July, county treasurers will receive a warrant that reflects state aid for elementary, high, and unified school districts; charter schools; and county offices of education for programs included in the 2010-11 Second Principal (P-2) Apportionment. Select county treasurers will receive a warrant towards the end of June for local educational agencies that qualified to receive a payment pursuant to California *Education Code (EC)* Section 14041.7. The California Department of Education (CDE) certified P-2 on June 15, 2011, pursuant to *EC* Section 41335. The statewide total was \$25,152,410,733.

This apportionment includes funding for 2010-11 as well as updated funding for the 2009-10 apportionment (2009-10 Annual R1), the 2008-09 apportionment (2008-09 Annual R3), and adjustments to other prior-year apportionments, as necessary.
