Re: 2011-12 Basic Aid Reduction

The purpose of this e-mail is to notify you that the California Department of Education (CDE) has posted a list of school districts that were basic aid in 2010-11 and the amount that their categorical program allocations will be reduced in 2011-12 pursuant to the provisions of Section 56 of Senate Bill (SB) 70 (Chapter 7, Statutes of 2011). Specifically, SB 70 requires that fiscal year 2011-12 categorical funding allocations to school districts that were basic aid in fiscal year 2010-11 be reduced by the lesser of: (1) the district's 2010-11 total revenue limit subject to the deficit factor, calculated as of the 2010-11 certified second principal apportionment, multiplied by 8.92 percent or (2) the amount of the district's excess taxes.
