Re: Notice of Apportionments

The purpose of this bulletin is to notify you of the following apportionments that have been sent by the California Department of Education (CDE) to the State Controller's Office for payment:

• <u>Title III of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended by the No Child</u> <u>Left Behind Act of 2001</u>

This apportionment, in the amount of \$20,759,906, is made from federal funds provided to the state in support of grants awarded to eligible local educational agencies for supplementary programs and services to Limited English Proficient students.

• <u>Title II, Part A, of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended by the No</u> <u>Child Left Behind Act of 2001</u>

This apportionment, in the amount of \$68,486,833, is made from federal funds provided to the state in support of grants awarded to eligible local educational agencies (LEAs) to achieve student academic achievement through strategies focused on recruiting, hiring, training, and retaining highly qualified teachers and principals.

• <u>Title II, Part A, of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended by the No</u> <u>Child Left Behind Act of 2001</u>

This apportionment, in the amount of \$3,651,826, is made from federal funds provided to the state in support of grants awarded to eligible local educational agencies to achieve student academic achievement through strategies focused on recruiting, hiring, training, and retaining highly qualified teachers and principals.
