Re: Education Jobs Fund Entitlement Revisions are Available

The purpose of this e-mail is to notify you that the Education Jobs Fund (Ed Jobs) entitlements have been revised and are available on the California Department of Education's (CDE) Web site at http://www.cde.ca.gov/fg/aa/ca/edjobsfund.asp. After final entitlements were published in July 2011, California received an additional grant from the U.S. Department of Education for Ed Jobs in the amount of \$17.7 million. As a result entitlements have been recalculated to distribute the additional funding to local educational agencies (LEAs) that applied for the program. An LEA's revised final Ed Jobs entitlement is equal to 3.762 percent of its 2010-11 P-2 revenue limit or charter school general purpose funding.

The revised final Ed Jobs entitlement Excel file includes two additional worksheets. One worksheet lists the source data used to determine each LEA's revenue limit funding and the second provides information on locally funded charter school data that was aggregated into the charter authorizer entitlement. I have included Santa Clara County School's information below for your convenience.

Due to federal cash management requirements, future apportionments of Ed Jobs funds will be based on expenditure information reported to the CDE via the quarterly ARRA Section 1512 reports. LEAs will not receive any remaining funds due without submitting the required quarterly Section 1512 reports. The next reporting cycle will cover expenditures from August 10, 2010 through March 31, 2012, and will be due this month. Additional information about Section 1512 reporting is available at http://www.cde.ca.gov/ar/rr/.

As a reminder, Ed Jobs funds must be obligated by September 30, 2012.
