Re: Direct Funded Charter School Retirement Reporting-

Update on the COE Portal for STRS (Charter Connect) Submission -

April STRS Retirement Files must be submitted via Charter Connect- Due May 15th

The purpose of this bulletin is to remind all Direct Funded Charter Schools to submit their STRS Retirement files and contributions by the due date and include the STRS generated report signifying that it is error free. The .txt file must be in the format prescribed by CalSTRS, and must be accompanied with the error free File Detail Report from the CalSTRS Secure Employee Website (SEW).

Several Bulletins<sup>i</sup> have been distributed to notify the Charter Schools of the changes and the requirements and I have referenced them below for your information. Copies of these documents can be found on the Santa Clara County Office of Education website. (http://www.sccoe.org/depts/dbas/portal/bulletins.asp)

While California Education Code (EC) 47611.3<sup>ii</sup> provides guidance on retirement reporting for Charter Schools, specifically the responsibility and authority for these requirements; we want to make sure that we have provided the support needed to successfully meet the changes required by STRS.

Based on your feedback, we have revised the Charter School Connect portal<sup>iii</sup> to allow you to enter your data easily and extract data to produce a .txt file for uploading to the SEW system. Since April payroll information is due to the Santa Clara County Office of Education on May 15<sup>th</sup>; and is expected to be submitted through this portal, we have scheduled two separate lab workshops for those of you needing assistance. You will learn what you need to know to create and submit your files directly. Information on these labs is listed below<sup>iv</sup>. *Please register on line*.

Late submissions or failure to remit employee and employer contributions by the stated deadlines can lead to penalties and interest charges, which will be passed along to the responsible Charter School. The submission deadlines for the 2011-12 and 2012-13 fiscal years are listed below.

Remittance of contributions is due at the same time as the file and reports and can be submitted to:

(b)As a condition of creating and submitting reports for the State Teachers' Retirement System and the Public Employees Retirement System, the school district or county office of education shall not require a charter school to purchase payroll processing services from the chartering authority. Information submitted on behalf of the charter school to the State Teachers' Retirement System, the Public Employees' Retirement System, or both, shall be in a format conforming to the requirements of those systems.

ii Per California Education Code (Ed Code) 47611.3 (a)At the request of a charter school, a school district or county office of education that is the chartering authority of a charter school shall create any reports required by the State Teachers' Retirement System and the Public Employees' Retirement System. The county superintendent of schools, employing agency, or school district that reports to those systems pursuant to Section 23004 of this code or Section 20221 of the Government Code shall submit the required reports on behalf of the charter school. The school district or county office of education may charge the charter school for the actual costs of the reporting services.
