Re: 2012–13 Mandate Block Grant- Verification of Accuracy by October 26th

The purpose of this bulletin is to notify you that the California Department of Education (CDE), School Fiscal Services Division has posted a list of local education agencies (LEAs) that have submitted a Mandate Block Grant (MBG) Letter of Intent.

Included on the list are the 2011–12 Second Principal Apportionment (P-2) average daily attendance (ADA) used to calculate the 2012–13 MBG funding and the total 2012–13 entitlement for each participating LEA. The MBG will be funded for 2012–13 at the following rates (no proration):

School Districts	\$28 per prior year ADA
Charter Schools	\$14 per prior year ADA
County Offices of Education (COE)	\$28 per prior year ADA plus an additional \$1 per ADA for all prior year revenue limit ADA generated by school districts and the COE within that county.

The CDE will issue the apportionment payment for the MBG in November 2012.
