Re: Exchange and Sojourn Teachers

Any teacher employed by school district through a process established in Education Code 44853 or 44856 is considered an "exchange" or "sojourn" teacher irrespective of their visa status.

Persons serving as exchange teachers or sojourn teachers from outside of California are excluded from both membership in the Defined Benefit Program (DB) and participating in the Cash Balance Benefit Program (CB) pursuant to Education Code 22601.

Previously, California State Teachers' Retirement System (CalSTRS) directed school districts to report compensation for exchange and sojourn teachers using Assignment Code 62 on the F496 File. This functionality is slated to be discontinued when CalSTRS deploys its new pension administration system. In the meantime, school districts may continue to report compensation for exchange and sojourn teachers but are not required to do so.
