Re: Classified School Employee Summer Assistance Program (CSESAP): Schedule of the Estimated State

Match Funding for the School Year 2023-24 (Revision of Bulletin 23-026)

The purpose of this bulletin is to inform districts that the State Match Funding amount has increased from eighty cents (\$0.80) to ninety-six cents (\$0.96) for each one dollar (\$1) that the participating classified employee elected to withhold monthly in the 2023-24 school year. The California Department of Education (CDE) will make the required apportionment for the match funds in August 2024.

Per the CDE's letter dated September 28, 2023, the schedule of the estimated amount of State Match Funding for each participating school district is available under "CSESAP 2022 Funding Results" on the CDE website at

Classified School Employee Summer Assistance Program (CSESAP) Program Funding Fiscal Year 2022-23 for School Year 2023-24 Important Dates				
During the 2023- 24 school year	The district will withhold the specified amount from an employee's monthly paychecks (up to 10% of gross salary) that the employee indicated on the election form.  Employees who separate from employment during the 2023-24 school year:  Are not entitled to the match fund if the employees request to receive the funds withheld from their monthly paychecks during the school year at the time of separation.  Are entitled to the match fund if the employees do not request to immediately receive the funds withheld from their monthly paychecks during the school year.			
By July 31, 2024	Districts submit a web-based form to request payment at <a href="https://www.cde.ca.gov/fg/fo/r14/csesap23rfa.asp">https://www.cde.ca.gov/fg/fo/r14/csesap23rfa.asp</a> on or before July 31, 2024, for the actual amount of classified employee pay withheld.			
During summer recess in 2024	Districts must pay their classified employees the amounts withheld plus the state match funds. The summer recess payments are to be made either in one or two payments, as specified by the classified employees at the time of enrollment.
